***What preparation will my child need in order to receive First Holy Communion?***

**Children who:**

- \* are in at least second grade**
- \* have been in religious education for at least one year**
- \* have been baptized and**
- \* have made their First Reconciliation**

**Are eligible to receive their First Holy Communion.**

**Parents must submit a copy of the child's baptismal record before October 1, 2008.**



***Will there be any special classes that we need to attend?***

**Yes, along with taking religion at either St. Peter's Catholic School or attending Parish School of Religion on Wednesday evenings, some special parent- sessions will be offered.**

**Parents may choose to attend either the Wednesday evening or Thursday afternoon sessions.**

**The sessions are actually duplicates. You can pick either the Wednesday or Thursday depending on what fits your schedule the best.**
