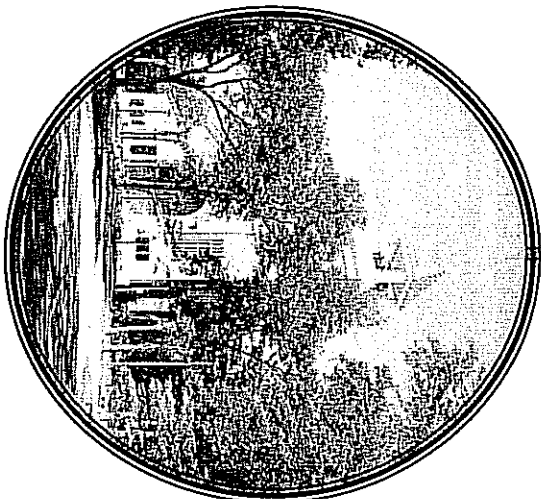

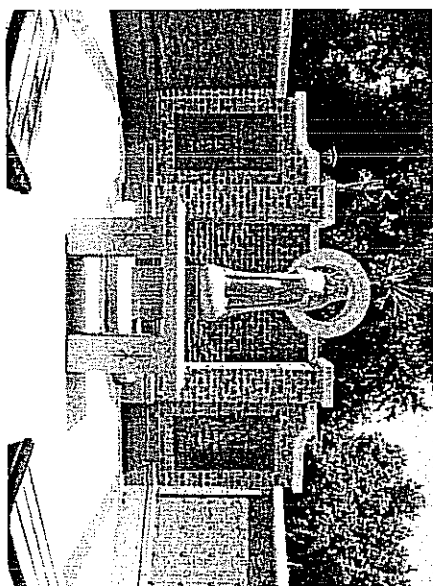

## WHY A COLUMBARIUM FOR

### ST. PETER'S

Columbariums are becoming the preferred form of interment for some, and St. Peter's continues to fulfill that need.

We believe interment on the church grounds is a statement of our faith in the Resurrection and the Church Triumphant.

Beginning in 2000, the pastor and parishioners envisioned building a Columbarium at St. Peter's. Phase I became a reality in November of 2007.

The Columbarium Garden is designed around the pond at the heart of our parish campus. The focal point of the Columbarium Garden is a statue of Our Lady of Fatima and the associated altar. Aligning the Columbarium Garden with the church serves to accentuate the everlasting continuum of our faith journey with God. Phases II and III will continue to be built around the pond, creating a tranquil setting conducive to visitation, prayer and reflection.

Due to overwhelming interest in the Columbarium Garden, all 48 niches in Phase I have been licensed and reserved. It is now necessary to begin construction of Phase II.

## WHAT IS A COLUMBARIUM?

A columbarium is a physical structure for the interment of cremated remains of loved ones, providing a contemporary setting for the traditional cemetery. The area surrounding a columbarium is usually landscaped into a garden that enhances its beauty. The word "columbarium" is derived from the Latin word "Columba" (dove), the symbol of the Holy Spirit and the Christian symbol of peace.

## HOW DOES THIS WORK?

Niches in the Columbarium Garden are leased in the same way that cemetery plots are leased. With the leasing of a niche, the members receive the following:

- ◆ License for the niche and perpetual care
- ◆ Regulations and operating rules
- ◆ Certificate acknowledging the exclusive right of use indicating the specific niche and its location
- ◆ License receipt upon payment
- ◆ Memorial plaques may be purchased

## HOW MUCH DO NICHE COST IN PHASE II?

The Columbarium, a stand-alone project, functions in a separate parish account .
